- Background speakers-level Persian and Russian (2 hours 50 minutes)
- Continuers-level Albanian, Armenian, Bosnian, Croatian, Dutch, Filipino, Hebrew, Hindi, Hungarian, Khmer, Macedonian, Maltese, Polish, Portuguese, Punjabi, Romanian, Russian, Serbian, Sinhala, Swedish, Tamil, Turkish, Ukrainian, and Yiddish (2 hours 50 minutes).

Students will be notified in September of the arrangements for these examinations and the oral examinations.
